As such we offer several programs geared towards children. Programs can be taken at our site, provided by the ASC at your site – or you can offer some of our programs yourself.

Pedal Pushers™ (5 – 8 yr olds)

Pedal Pushers™ is a bicycle-training program designed to create good bicycle related habits at a young age. The course identifies the importance of bicycle inspection, proper bicycle fit, legal requirements and safety equipment. Proper equipment, including a helmet and bicycle, is required to participate. Students must provide their own bicycle and helmet.

Program modules include:

- The bicycle as a vehicle
- Signs and signals
- Getting started on your vehicle
- Taking your place in traffic
- Intersections
- Right and left turns

Intermediate Pedal Pushers™ (9-12 year olds)

Intermediate Pedal Pushers™ is a 5 day Camp Style, 15 hour bicycle program. It is designed for children with basic bicycle skills who would like to improve their bicycle riding techniques. Children who successfully pass the course will be awarded a certification card. Students must provide their own bicycle and helmet.

Activities include:

- Traffic skills
- Collision avoidance manoeuvres
- Obstacle courses
- Bicycle tour planning; Trail riding
- Bicycle maintenance
- Classroom instruction
- Written and Skills Tests

Scooter Parties (4 – 7 years)

Celebrating a birthday? Holding a family reunion? Club or organization year-end event? Scooter parties are two hours in length and start with 10 – 15 minutes of classroom instruction on the 7 steps of safely crossing the street. The remainder of the first hour is spent riding the battery operated scooters in Safety City. The second hour your group has use of our Fire Safe Room for food and other activities. Scooter parties available weekends and evenings.

Scooter Drop-ins (4 – 7 years)

Throughout the summer the Alberta Safety Council holds weekly drop-in sessions for children 4-7 year olds to come out and ride the battery-operated scooters. Please call the office for times.
